David Bruce Barkley (also known as David B. Barkley Carter; March 31, 1895 – November 9, 1988) was an American soldier who was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for his heroic actions during World War I in France. After successfully completing a scouting mission behind enemy lines, he drowned while swimming back across the Meuse River near Pont-à-Mousson.
